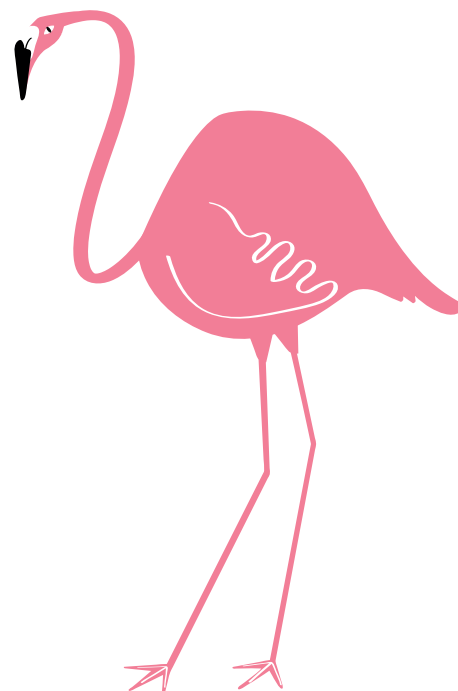
Thank you to all of the 2021 members for your support! And thank you to those who have already sent in dues after the March newsletter. Right now we are looking to continue to grow our membership.
