

The election is right around the corner, so please get to know the candidates. Your vote affects not only our city, but our neighborhood.

In addition to the St. Pete. mayoral race, the District 1 City Council seat is on the ballot.

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections will send out mail-in ballots starting Sept. 28
